Please find some additional guidance below regarding Key Stage 3 Report Cards which were issued this week and are available to download from Bromcom. The report is meant to give a brief overview of how you child has settled in during their first few weeks at Hampton College. In addition, we envisage this report card being a helpful conversation point at the Year 7 Tutor Evening scheduled to take place on 20th October.

Grading on the card

All of the categories on the report card are graded from 5 (excellent) to 1 (cause for concern).

ATL - This stands for Attitude to Learning and covers the way in which a student approaches their lessons. It covers punctuality, effort with classwork and homework, having appropriate equipment for the lesson, meeting the expectations of the class teacher and demonstrating the overall school ethos of Progress, Partnership & Pride in class.

Conduct - this relates to the student's general behaviour in class, their respect for other people in the lesson, and overall preparedness to learn.

Home Learning - this covers to what extent homework is attempted, completed on time, well presented and carried out with a high level of care and effort. If limited home learning has been set so far this year in a particular subject the report card will say 'N/A'.

Target grades and teacher-assessed grades will be included on the next report card in January. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
